ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

At the outset, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, submits that petitioner is no longer executing the work that has been assigned to him, pursuant to the work order dated 11.04.2023 (P-1). For, during the currency of the contract, the petitioner himself submitted the resignation and voluntarily chose not to execute the contract any further. Thus, the challenge laid to clause 5 (1) C. of the Punjab Food Grains Labour & Cartage Policy, 2023 (P-2), is apparently academic in nature. That being so, the petition at hand has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of, as such.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the abovesaid factual position, and submits that let the petition be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

In the wake of the above, the petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, in the given circumstances, challenge laid to clause 5 (1) C. of the Punjab Food Grains Labour & Cartage Policy, 2023 (P-2), shall be examined in appropriate proceedings.
