1. The counsel for the petitioner submits that the application under Section 133 Cr.P.C. filed by respondents No.3 & 4 against the petitioner was allowed by the Court of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Bathinda vide order dated 23.10.2023. Being aggrieved, petitioner filed criminal revision petition against the said order and the same is pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda. That in the said revision petition, the petitioner also sought interim relief and made prayer seeking stay of aforesaid order dated 23.10.2023 passed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, concerned. That however, the revisional Court while admitting the revision petition vide order (Annexure P-8) dated 27.12.2023 failed to take into notice, the aforesaid prayer for grant of interim relief and order (Annexure

P-8) is completely silent with regard to prayer seeking interim relief during the pendency of the revision petition. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that being aggrieved, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents not to close/shut the operation of the RO plant run by the petitioner.

2. In view of the fact that the criminal revision petition is pending at present before the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda, the present petition is hereby disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case with directions to the revisional Court concerned to consider the prayer made by the petitioner in his revision petition seeking interim relief, on the next date fixed in the said revision petition or within 15 days thereof.

3. The present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
