1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 2 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 01.06.2023 passed in CRM-M-28392-2023 and subsequent order dated 09.10.2023 passed in CRM-42607-2023 in CRM-M-28392-2023.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of the respondent filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the orders dated 01.06.2023 and 09.10.2023 have since been complied with. The grievance of the petitioner as raised in the representation, has been considered, speaking order (Annexure R-2) has been passed and even the Special Investigating Team has been constituted for investigation. Now, the warrant of arrest has been issued against the accused.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
