JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that during the pendency of the present writ petition, various payments have already been made to the petitioner but some of the payments are still remaining and with regard to the remaining payments, he seeks liberty to file another representation before the concerned authority or to file a separate writ petition.
2. In view of the aforesaid submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of. Liberty is granted to the petitioner that in case some amount is still left, then any representation may be given to the respondent-Nigam and in the event of his doing so, the respondent-Nigam shall consider the same by passing an order within a period of three months thereafter. Liberty is also granted to the petitioner to challenge adverse order, if any, by filing a separate writ petition.
