The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing clause 2 and 8 of the appointment letter dated 03.12.1997, Annexure P-1, whereby the petitioner's appointment to the post of Demonstrator in the respondent-Medical College has been restricted to three years.

2. Vide interim order dated 30.11.2000, the respondents were restrained from terminating the petitioner's service as Demonstrator, and he was allowed to continue beyond the expiry of his tenure without confirming any right on the post.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has been appointed Assistant Professor in the Medical College, and the petition as such has been rendered

infructuous. He, however, seeks liberty to claim benefits for the service rendered by the petitioner as Demonstrator from the respondents, in accordance with law.

4. The petition, accordingly, stands disposed of with liberty prayed for.
