The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct respondents No.1 to 4 to produce the alleged detainee, namely, Mansimran Singh (son of the petitioner), who has been illegally detained by respondents No.5 to 8 since 08.02.2024.

In compliance of the order dated 15.02.2024 passed by this Court, respondent No.4 has produced the alleged detainee, namely, Mansimran Singh. I have interacted with the alleged detainee, who has submitted that he is aged about 29 years and is a property dealer. He has further submitted that at present he is residing voluntarily in Ludhiana with respondent No.5 and has not been detained/confined by anyone including respondents No.5 to 8.

In view of the statement made by the alleged detainee, no further orders are required to be passed and the present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
