1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.287 dated 7.7.2021, under Sections 363 and 366-A of the IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Adarsh Nagar, Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.
2. Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner, as per which, the petitioner has undergone custody for a period of 3 years, 3 months and 5 days.
3. The age of the petitioner is 36 years whereas the age of the prosecutrix is 16 years at the time of incident. A detailed order had already

been passed on 22.12.2023 in CRM-M-60772-2022, whereby the bail application of the petitioner was dismissed on merits. Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to show any change of circumstances. Both the prosecutrix and father of the prosecutrix who appeared as PW1 and PW-2, respectively have supported the prosecution case. The prosecutrix was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. In such circumstances, no ground is made out to grant the regular bail to the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
5. Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
