Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the order dated 04.08.1997 (Annexure P-9) whereby the pay parity claim of the petitioners with the similar cadre of the Sub-Station Attendant has been rejected. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to equate the pay scale of the petitioners with that of Sub-Station Attendant, working with the respondents and release all arrears of salary along with other consequential benefits.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 09.08.2024, learned counsel for the parties sought adjournment to complete their instructions.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioners.

In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

However liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the present petition in case any cause still survives.
