1. Learned counsel for the respondent has filed her power of attorney in the Court which is taken on record.

The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 10.09.1996 (Annexure P/4) and further sought a writ of mandamus directing the respondent-Board to grant pay scale of Rs.1200-2200/- and Rs.1640-2950/- after 9 years of service and Rs.2000-3500/- after 16 years of service to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.01.1986 as given to the Sub Station Attendants vide Annexure P/2 with all benefits.
3. On the last date of hearing i.e. 27.02.2024, the following order as passed :-
