This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 19.09.2023 passed in CWP-20884-2023.

2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the Registrar, Haryana State Pharmacy Council, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 19.09.2023 passed in CWP-20884-2023 has been complied with and the registration certificate (Annexure R-1) has been issued to the petitioner.
