Petitioner prays for issuing necessary direction to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and his wife at the hand of private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the resident of U.S.A. However, he has property in India. When he came to India to sell his property, he was being threatened by the private respondents and thus the life and liberty of the petitioner and his wife is in danger. However, it is informed that the petitioner has since gone to U.S.A. He wants to come back, so as to sell his property, but unable to do so because of the threats being extended to him.

5. This petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court as and when he intends to come back to India. In the meantime, respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Sri Amritsar Sahib, shall look into the representations Annexures P-2 to P-4 moved by the petitioners.
