The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the General Diary Details No.48 dated 04.04.2023 (P-13) and the final order dated 07.12.2023 passed by SDM, UT Chandigarh (P-14) including subsequent, incidental and consequential proceedings arisen from the same qua the petitioners; ii. Not to register any false, frivolous case against the petitioners; iii. To decide the representations and take strict legal action against culprit respondent No. 6 and 7 in view of law laid down by *Apex Court in Writ Petition (Criminal) No. 68 of 2008 in case titled "Lalita Kumari Versus Govt. of U.P. and others," decided on 12.11.2013*. iv. To protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members and not to harass and embarrass the petitioners at the behest of respondent No.6 & 7.

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent-U.T., Chandigarh submits that the authorities have already examined the case and exonerated the petitioners in proceedings under Section 105 and 150 Cr.P.C. in GD No.48 dated 04.04.2023.

As far as prayer made by the petitioners for seeking protection to life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7 is concerned, a representation dated 29.03.2023 (Annexure P-10) is stated to have been filed before Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh via email at pssput.chd@nic.in, which is still pending and no heed has been paid to the same.

Respondent No.4 is directed to examine the said representation dated 29.03.2023 (Annexure P-10) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from today by passing a speaking order, a copy of which shall be furnished to the petitioners within a period of three days thereafter.

In the light of above, nothing survives in the present petition and the same has been rendered infructuous since the relief sought in the instant petition stands addressed.

The present petition is disposed off as such.
