Mr. Tanvir Singh Attriwala, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondents No.5 and 6, by filing his Vakalatnama, and the same is taken on record.

The petitioner has filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of alleged, detainee, namely, Ekta Chaudhary, who has been illegally detained by respondents No.5 and 6.

In compliance of the order dated 16.02.2024, the respondent No.4 has produced the alleged, detainee, namely, Ekta Chaudhary D/o Danni Chaudhary before this Court. I have interacted with the alleged, detainee, namely, Ekta Chaudhary. She submits that she is more than 18 years of age and a minor. She is a student of B. Arch in Bundelkhand, Jhansi, U.P. At present, she is staying with her parents i.e. respondents No.5 and 6 at A-89,

Phase-I, New Palam Vihar, Gurugram, Haryana. She further submits that she wishes to stay with her parents only.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satbir Singh submits that the police had gone to the residence of respondents No.5 and 6 and have recorded the statement of alleged, detainee, namely, Ekta Chaudhary. In her statement she submits that she is happily and voluntarily living with her parents i.e. respondents No.5 and 6 in their house A-89, Phase-I, New Palam Vihar, Gurugram, Haryana.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.5 and 6 also submits that the alleged, detainee, namely, Ekta Chaudhary is living happily with parents i.e. respondents No.5 and 6 in their house A-89, Phase-I, New Palam Vihar, Gurugram, Haryana and the present petition is frivolous.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel and the alleged detainee, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.
