**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)**

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 11.08.2023 passed in CWP-14748-2020.
2. Affidavit of Virender Singh, IFS, Divisional Forest Officer, Yamuna Nagar, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 11.08.2023 passed in CWP-14748-2020 has been complied with and the petitioners have been promoted to the post of Forest Guards, as would decipher from the orders dated 12.03.2024 (Annexures R-1 and R-2).
4. Counsel for the petitioners has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
