The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 29.07.1999 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.3 vide which the representation of the petitioners has been rejected without specifying that respondent Nos.4 to 11, who have joined the service much later than petitioners and their services had been regularized ignoring the petitioners' seniority for regularization and also by adopting the policy of pick and choose as petitioners are much senior to respondent Nos.4 to 11.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has produced a copy of order dated 07.03.2006 passed by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh, whereby Tarn Taran Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd., Tarn Taran (respondent No.3) has been ordered to be wound up and appointed the Joint

Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Jalandhar as Liquidator of the Mill under

Section 58 of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961.

3. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.
