1. The present petition was filed by petitioner Rajan Bansal seeking issuance of writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to produce detainee Nitika @ Nitika Choudhary who was allegedly detained by respondents No.4 to 6.
2. The plea of the petitioner is that Nitika @ Nitika Choudhary is his wife and they solemnized marriage on 05.02.2024.
3. On the last date of hearing, directions was given to the official respondents to produce the alleged detainee in the Court.
4. In compliance of the said order, Nitika @ Nitika Choudhary appeared in Court along with her father and made statement that she is happily living with her parents and is not under any pressure and she wants

to go with her parents only and further stated that she has got no relationship with the petitioner.

5. Status report filed by way of affidavit of Ms. Heena Gupta, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Mansa is taken on record along with documents Annexures R-1 and R-2. As per Annexure R-1 which is a school certificate date of birth of Nitika is 07.12.2006.

6. In view of the above, no case for interference is made out as Nitika Choudhary is willing to live with her parents. Consequently, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
