1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 23.09.2022 passed in CWP-2511-2021.
2. Mr. H.S.Oberoi, Advocate, files his power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.3, which is take on record.
3. Compliance affidavit of Navneet Gupta, Principal Accountant General (A & E), Haryana, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for respondent No.3 has submitted that necessary payments have already been made to the petitioner. The document to that effect has also been placed on record.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered
infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-
redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate
remedy, but in accordance with law.
