Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the Instructions dated 09.03.2000 (Annexure P-4). Further a writ of prohibition has been sought for staying the operation of the Instructions dated 09.03.2000 (Annexure P-4), qua the petitioners. Lastly, a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to allow the petitioners for the pay-scale of Rs.2200-4250 being 50 years of age and seniority of the petitioners may not be disturbed or lowered down.

The present petition only survives on behalf of petitioner No.2. Since there was no representation on behalf of petitioner No.2 on

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the last date of hearing, notice was ordered to be issued to petitioner No.2 for today.

As per office report, notice issued to petitioner No.2 has been received back unserved with the report that he has retired from service.

Since, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
