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**JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (ORAL)**

1. At the outset, Mr. Jagbir Malik, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.2 to 4 submitted that since the petitioners have already filed their objections to the tentative ranking list of technical subordinates, he has clear instructions from Mr. Pawan Kumar, U/S, HR-III, DHBVN, Hisar, who is present in Court today, to state that without considering each and every objection of the petitioners and without passing an order on the aforesaid objections the tentative ranking list will not be finalized.

2. Mr. Anurag Chopra, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in view of the aforesaid submissions made by the learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4, the present petition can be disposed of. He has however submitted that there is a likelihood that the petitioners may

still not be put in the ranking list because of the frivolous grounds taken by the respondents on the earlier occasions and in case any adverse order is passed against the petitioner, then five days’ time may be granted in order to challenge the order, if any, passed against the petitioners and the final list may not be made operational for a period of five days after the same is finalized.

3. Mr. Jagbir Malik, learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4 stated that the aforesaid limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners appears to be genuine and they will not give effect to the orders final ranking list for a period of five days immediately after it is finalized.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement made by both the learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of.
