1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to appoint them as Constables in terms of selection list circulated vide memorandum dated 02.08.1999.

2. Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that all the petitioners were permitted to join on the claimed post. The petitioner No.4 came to be dismissed vide order dated 04.04.2003 on account of misconduct, thus, prayer sought by petitioners has rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners expressed his inability to controvert the aforesaid factual position, however, seeks liberty to move an appropriate application if cause survives.



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4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
