1. By way of present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have approached this Court, *interalia*, for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of letters dated 19.09.2019, Annexure P2, 25.07.2022, Annexure P5 and 01.12.2023, Annexure P6 as according to them the letters have been issued in contravention of Section 48(6) of The Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961.

2. At the outset counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have raised their grievance by submitting a legal notice dated

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10.12.2023, Annexure P7, which is pending and they would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to look into it.

- 3. Issue notice to the respondents.
- 4. On asking, Mr.Amit Chaudhary, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent.
- 5. Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call for a response from the respondents.
- 6. Without examining the merits of the grievance raised by the petitioners, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to examine the legal notice, Annexure P7 and pass an appropriate order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
