The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.652 dated 24.11.2023 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 325, 506 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Pataudi, District Gurugram.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 28.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 02.04.2024 by way of an affidavit of Harinder Kumar, HPS, Asstt. Commissioner of Police, Pataudi, Gurugram has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 28.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
