1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 23.08.2023 passed in CWP-18421-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 23.08.2023 passed in CWP-18421-2023 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 09.04.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 09.04.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
