The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.0033 dated 29.01.2024, under Sections 120-B, 419, 420, 467 and 468 of the IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector-5, District Panchkula.

This Court vide order dated 29.02.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation but he has not joined the investigation. On the last date of hearing i.e. 21.03.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner sought another opportunity to join the investigation and the petitioner was again directed to join the investigation as last opportunity and it was made clear in the order that in case of failure to do the needful, the interim protection granted to the petitioner by this Court shall automatically stands vacated.

Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar, submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to rebut the said fact.

In view of the above, this Court has left with no other option but to dismiss the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
