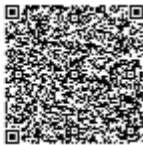
NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to pay/release the pension and other pending retiral benefits i.e. G.P.F., leave encashment, gratuity etc. and all other retiral benefits of the petitioner along with 18% interest.

2. On 25.04.2024, the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that all the retiral dues of the petitioner such as gratuity, leave encashment and G.P.F. have been released along with the interest @ 9% per annum. He further submits that even, the arrears of pension have been released. He seeks time to get instructions whether the arrears of pension which have been released includes interest or not and if necessary, they may file an affidavit to that effect.

On his request, adjourned to 25.07.2024.”



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3. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that all the retiral dues of the petitioner have been released along with 9% interest except arrears of pension.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with the relief granted by respondent No.4 and submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
5. Disposed of as having become infructuous.
