HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that father of the petitioner, who was working with the Haryana Police, unfortunately died on 28.01.2014 while in service but the petitioner has not been given the benefit of compassionate appointment though, keeping in view the instructions which were applicable at the time of the death, the petitioner was entitled for the grant of the said benefit.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure P-13) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure P-13) has been received in the office and is still pending consideration, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
