1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 16.11.2023 passed in CWP-24822-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent has submitted that order dated 16.11.2023 passed in CWP-24822-2023 has since been complied with and the petitioner has been permitted to re-join her duties as Extension Lecturer, Physics, in the Govt. College, Nahar, Rewari. Copy of joining report dated 20.07.2024 qua that effect has been filed by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
