The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent Department to step-up the petitioner's pay at par with that of his junior/third respondent.

2. At the outset, learned State counsel contends that the petitioner's representation dated 09.08.2019, Annexure P-6, seeking the aforesaid relief is pending with the second respondent/Director Elementary Education, and will be decided by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks.

3. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

4. Ordered accordingly.

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5. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
