1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of orders dated 31.08.1999 (Annexure P-14), 11.09.1999 (Annexure P-15) and 08.03.2000 (Annexure P-18) whereby rank of ASI/ORP was withdrawn.

2. Mr. Aman Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab submits that the petitioner was promoted to the post of Assistant Sub-Inspector and thereafter, Sub-Inspector. He was further promoted to the post of Inspector (Local Rank). He retired on 31.05.2019 on attaining the age of superannuation. The rank of ORP is not a regular rank and it is not matter of right. In view of changed circumstances, the present petition has rendered infructuous.

3. Dismissed as infructuous.

4.           The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if cause survives.
