1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner, claiming the following relief:-

"a) Issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari/ Mandamus or such other appropriate writ, order or direction declaring the action of the Respondents in suspending the Resolution dated 31.5.1999 whereby the petitioner was reinstated into service and declaring the action of the Respondents in not allowing the petitioner to work as Part-time Sweeper and further not considering her claim of regularisation on the post of Sweeper as being illegal, arbitrary, malafide, un-constitutional and violative of Articles 14 & 16 of the Constitution of India.

b) Issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the Respondents to reinstate the petitioner into service and consider her claim for regularisation keeping in view her about 20 years service as Part-time Sweeper."

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.4, on the basis of service book of the petitioner, submits that the services of the petitioner were regularized on the post of Sweeper vide order dated 11.07.2003, thereafter, she has retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.01.2012 and all the retiral dues of the petitioner have been released on 03.09.2012. She further submits that in view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioner.

4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

5. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition in case, any cause still survives.
