AMAN CHAUDHARY. J. (ORAL)

1. This common order shall dispose of above-mentioned two petitions as they involve the same issue.
2. The present civil writ petitions have been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent authorities to send the candidates for training and to absorb the employees in the Revenue Department.
3. Learned counsel submit that all the petitioners have since retired after getting promotions in the Departments, where they were working, though the claim in the present petitions were of their absorption in the Revenue Department, as the same may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
