1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside of notice dated 17.11.2020 (Annexure P-2) and notice dated 15.12.2020 (Annexure P-3), issued by respondent No.3, whereby they have been asked to return the amount of leave encashment paid to them at the time of their voluntary retirement and further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing respondent No.3 to return the amount of leave encashment unilaterally withdrawn from the bank accounts of the petitioner.

2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file afresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars and by impleading the necessary parties.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
