1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to consider case of petitioner for promotion to the post of Superintendent Grade-I.
2. Mr. Ishan Gupta, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is due to retire from service on 30.04.2024 and he is entitled to promotion to the post of Superintendent Grade-I. The said post is lying vacant since August' 2023 and respondents are not deciding his fate. He has filed multiple representations including representation dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) but to no avail. The grievance of the petitioner, at this stage would be redressed, if respondents are directed to decide his representation in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.

Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service.

With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.

Learned State counsel asserts that respondents/Competent Authority would look into the representation of the petitioner and an appropriate order shall be passed within 4 weeks from today.

In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents/Competent Authority to decide representation of the petitioner within 4 months from today.
