This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 25.06.2019 passed in CWP-17166-2019.

Pursuant to previous order dated 05.01.2024, costs of Rs.15,000/- has been deposited. Receipt to this effect has been placed on record. The same is taken on record.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondents that the present contempt petition has been filed qua an interim order passed in CWP-17166-2019. However, now even the said writ petition has been dismissed declining the claim of the petitioners, as such.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the contempt petition.
