Petitioners were on bail in a trial arising out of FIR No.70 dated 30.06.2019, under Sections 323, 336, 341, 427, 506, 160, 148 and 149 of IPC, despite Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Commissionerate Jalandhar, Punjab, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Jalandhar. Both the petitioners absented themselves on 23.01.2024 and their bail was cancelled and warrants of arrest were directed to be issued for 29.02.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners could not appear on 23.01.2024 due to noting of wrong date. He further contends that petitioners are ready to surrender before the Trial Court concerned and they be provided with necessary protection.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Amandeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

5. This petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 29.02.2024,

the date already fixed thereat. On their such surrender, the Trial Court shall initiate the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. and after disposal of those proceedings, the petitioners shall be admitted to bail. Till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioners shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, petitioners are sought to be arrested on account of warrants of arrest having been issued against them, they shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
