VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ directing the respondents to grant the senior scale to the petitioners as admissible after 5/10 years service to 40% of the total no. of posts of clerks.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the matter is of the year 1997 and in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioners to rebut the said aspect inspite of the report of the registry that the counsel for the petitioners has been informed.
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to them.
