1. Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of *certiorari* for quashing order dated 11.02.1999 (Annexure P-6), passed by respondent No.1 granting seniority to respondent No.3 over and above the petitioners.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, petitioners – Rakesh Chander and Pritam Singh as well as respondent No.3 – Bhagwant Singh have already retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 28.02.2018, 14.01.2014 and 30.06.2017, respectively.
