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1. This revision petition is filed under Article 227 of Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate direction to learned trial Court to decide civil suit bearing No CS.CJ-628-2016 within a specified period of time by binding down the parties to complete their evidence in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the suit was filed by the respondent/plaintiff in April 2016. Even issues were framed long time back. On 26.07.2019, evidence of the plaintiff/respondent No.1 was closed by order but it was ordered by the Court that in case plaintiff would bring any evidence on the next date, the Court might consider the same. Still evidence is not completed by the plaintiff. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if suit is disposed of in a time bound manner.

3. Heard.

4. From perusal of record, it transpires that issues in this case were framed on 15.01.2019. The plaintiff failed to produce the evidence. Vide order

dated 26.07.2019, evidence of the plaintiff was closed by an order. The Court was kind enough to ask the plaintiff to bring evidence on the next date and Court might consider the same. The plaintiff brought witnesses on the next date but only three witnesses were examined and thereafter the case is being adjourned one reason or the other but plaintiff has failed to conclude the evidence. The next date fixed in the trial Court is 07.03.2024. The parties are brothers and sisters and case is being lingered on without any reason.

5. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to dispose of the suit filed by the respondent/plaintiff expeditiously within a period of nine months by granting short adjournments. It may be ensure that no unnecessary adjournments shall be granted.
