1 Challenge in this petition is to order dated 03.04.1998 and order dated 27.11.1996 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) respectively, whereby application under Section 42 of East Punjab Holdings (Consolidation & Prevention of Fragmentation) Act, 1948, filed by respondents No.3 to 6 had been decided while setting aside the directions issued on 27.11.1996 passed in Case No.1331/93 that the existence of 'chah No.33/26' be set right as per the site and the boundary of rasta No.61 be corrected as per the site in record and ordered to be connected to the fields of respondent Ram Karan with deficiency on account of land coming in path to be made good from fields of respondent-Ram Karan. The decision was directed to be taken after inspecting the site and hearing the concerned.

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2 Present petition was admitted on 12.11.1998 and operation of orders dated 03.04.1998 and 27.11.1996 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) was stayed. Thereafter the matter came to be listed for hearing on 04.04.2024 but none had appeared on behalf of petitioner and notice was issued to petitioner for 29.04.2024.

3 As per office report, the petitioner is reported to have died. Mr. Sachin Mittal, Advocate, who appeared on 14.05.2024, stated that during pendency of this petition, the petitioner had passed away and he sought time to take steps for ensuring the substitution of said petitioner by his LRs. However, needful has not been done as it is informed that none of LRs of the petitioner have come forward to pursue the matter.

4 Today, learned counsel for petitioner however, submits that the registered letter sent by him to petitioner was received back with the report 'left'. He pleads no instructions.

5 Keeping in view the factual position as above, this petition is dismissed for non-prosecution, at this stage with liberty to file appropriate application for impleading LRs of the petitioner-Ghisha Singh within eight weeks. Copy of this order be conveyed at the given address of the petitioner.

6 Interim order granted on 12.11.1998 shall continue for the next eight weeks only.
