In the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner approached the Educational Tribunal, Punjab for the redressal of his grievance, which petition was dismissed by the Tribunal on the ground that the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction whereas, as per the judgment of the Coordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-22413-2021 titled as Paramjit Kaur vs. State of Punjab and others decided on 21.09.2023**, the similar claim has been referred to the Educational Tribunal for adjudication.

Learned counsel for the respondents concedes the said factum.

Keeping in view the fact that the question of jurisdiction of the Educational Tribunal already stands adjudicated by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in the case of **Paramjit Kaur (supra)** so as to have jurisdiction qua the claim raised, impugned order dated 23.10.2018 (Annexure P/10) is

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set aside.

Educational Tribunal, Punjab is requested by remanding the case back to adjudicate the claim of the petitioner on merits by passing appropriate speaking order.

Present petition stands disposed of.
