The petitioners have filed the present Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1972 with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the present petitioners as they were being harassed by respondents No.4 to 6.
2. A short reply by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran has been filed on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 6 and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners have neither been called at police station nor by the CIA Staff as alleged in the present case. He further submits that no criminal case has been registered against the present petitioners till date and in case involvement of the petitioners is

found in FIR No. 04 dated 14.01.2024 under Sections 302, 34 and 120-B IPC, Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms (offence 212 added later on) Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran or in any other case, prior notice shall be issued to the petitioners and the due process of law will be followed.

4. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.
