Prayer in the present application is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to follow the mandatory procedure of getting the measurement of land, prepare the Shajra Plan, prepare the Record of Rights by following the procedure as laid down in Section 32 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act 1887 and then to update the annual records in accordance with the Section 33 thereof on the basis of Dixit Award, 1974 and under the Haryana and Uttar Pradesh (Alteration and Boundaries), Act 1979 and further to get prepared Khasra girdawaries crop-wise upto date and to give demarcation of the holdings of the petitioner and others in view of the directions issued by this Court in CWP-8979-2009 and other connected petitions vide order dated 17.08.2011 (Annexure P-3) and further directing the respondents not to interfere into the peaceful possession of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has fairly submitted that the similar issue has been adjudicated by the Hon'ble Division Bench in

CWP No.22738 of 2016 (Balbhadur Singh (deceased) through

LRs and others Vs. State of Punjab and others), which has been disposed of vide order dated 19.03.2024. He has drawn attention of this Court to Para Nos.53 & 54 of the said order, wherein the Hon’ble Division Bench has given certain directions. He submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition to approach the respondents-authorities with his representation in view of the directions given by the Hon’ble Division Bench.

Allowed to do so.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation before the respondents-authorities as prayed for within 10 days from today. If any such representation is filed by the petitioners within the stipulated period, then the authority concerned is directed to decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.
