1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as Senior Scientific Officer (Biology).
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the present matter pertains to year 1998 and the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect. Even on 15.05.2001 and 22.11.2000, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner.
