Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the tentative seniority list issued by the respondent department on 31.05.2008 (Annexure P-5) and the order dated 03.07.2011 (Annexure P-11) as well as the order dated 06.12.2011 (Annexure P-12) passed by respondent by taking into consideration the Instructions dated 16.03.1962 (Annexure P-4) issued by the Government. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the official respondents to firstly consider the petitioners for promotion or for giving them the current duty charge of Sub-Divisional Engineer (Civil) as the petitioners are senior than that of the private respondents. Further prayer has been made to stay the operation of the impugned order dated 03.07.2011 (Annexure P-11) and the order dated 06.12.2011 (Annexure P-12) passed by respondent. Another prayer has been made to direct the official respondents not to promote/give current duty



charge to the respondent by ignoring the petitioners till the pendency of the writ petition.

There was no representation on behalf of the petitioners from the last four consecutive dates i.e. 18.05.2015, 15.10.2015, 15.01.2016 and 24.05.2024. Even today also, the position is the same.

It appears that the petitioners are not interested to pursue the present writ petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
