This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 04.11.2022 (Annexure P-2) and impugned summary of allegations (Annexure P-3) and impugned summary of allegations dated 21.11.2022 (Annexure P-4).

2. On 08.02.2024, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Learned State counsel has submitted that as per reply dated 28.08.2023, all the witnesses in the departmental proceedings have been examined and in the enquiry report, the petitioner has been held guilty and after the show cause notice, personal hearing was given to the petitioner wherein he had admitted his fault and but taking into consideration all the facts, a lenient view was taken and punishment of stoppage of six future annual increments with permanent effect was

awarded to the petitioner vide order dated 04.05.2023 and the petitioner had filed an appeal against the same in which the punishment was further reduced to three future annual increments with permanent effect vide order dated 27.06.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for an adjournment to get instructions in the matter.
