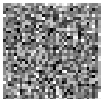

VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant compensation under the Haryana Victim Compensation Scheme, 2020, dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-2) to the daughter of the petitioner being rape victim.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the present writ petition be treated as a representation and competent authority be directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.



On the asking of the Court, Mr. Suneel Ranga, D.A.G., Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Mr. Edward Augustine George, Advocate, appears for respondent No.2 and files his Vakalatnama.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that they have no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.2-District Legal Services Authority, Panipat, is directed to take a decision on the prayer made by the petitioner by taking into consideration the averments made in the present petition and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner being established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of four months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
