1. On 17.03.2017, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioner has prayed for the release of the retiral benefits. The respondents had taken the plea in the written statement that an FIR and the departmental proceedings are pending. All this has happened in the year 1988.

Let the respondents file fresh status report by way of additional affidavit to explain about the status of the FIR and departmental proceedings and status of release of retiral benefits.

Adjourned to 5.7.2017.”

2. The respondent-State in compliance of aforesaid order filed affidavit dated 03.07.2017. In the said affidavit, the respondent has disclosed that all the retiral and other service benefits have already been paid to the petitioner, thus, the present petition has rendered infructuous.

3. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel as well as affidavit dated 03.07.2017, the present petition has rendered infructuous.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be granted liberty to avail remedy as permissible by law if some amount has remained unpaid.
5. Disposed of as infructuous with aforesaid liberty.
