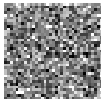

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer for conducting fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.6 dated 09.01.2024, under Sections 363 and 364 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspsur (Annexure P-2).
2. Learned State counsel while placing reliance upon the status report has contended that the victim has been traced on 05.03.2024 and produced before the Child Welfare Committee Gurdaspur. Learned State counsel further contended that the victim has been handed over to the complainant i.e. father of



the victim, and same has been recorded vide order dated 06.03.2024. He further submits that the accused persons involved in the commission of the alleged offence have been arrested and the investigating agency will proceed in accordance with law.

3. In view of the said status report, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
