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The present application has been filed by the applicant-
petitioner for placing on record Annexure P-12.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is
allowed and Annexures P-12 is taken on record.

The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
is for the issuance of directions to the official respondents to provide
adequate security to the petitioner on account of threats being faced by
him at the hands of dreaded gangsters.

Notice of motion was issued in this case and on 27.02.2024,
the following order was passed:-

*“The prayer in the petition under 482 Cr.PC is for
issuance of directions to the official respondents to
provide adequate security to the petitioner who face*



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threat to his life at the instance of certain dreaded gangsters.

The Counsel for the State on instructions submits that the threat perception assessment is being carried out by the investigating agency. In the meantime, a PCR has been posted near the place of the residence of the petitioner.

Be that as it may, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali is directed to provide two gunman to the petitioner in the interim. Further, if on threat assessment it is found that the petitioner does not require the protection, the said gunman may be taken back.

Adjourned to 02.04.2024.”

The matter was adjourned from time to time.

A status report dated 23.07.2024 by way of an affidavit of Ajay Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Security Punjab, Chandigarh has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh stated today that two gunmen provided to the petitioner shall continue to remain in the service of the petitioner until further orders.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
