Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing Annexure P-12 dated 25.09.1998 by which respondent No. 5 has been appointed as 'B' Class Tehsildar and also quashing the impugned selection of respondent No. 5 as 'B' Class Tehsildar.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the present matter pertains to year 1998 and the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.
4. Dismissed for non-prosecution. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition, in case, any cause of action survives.
